

# Fundraising Toolkit

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#### About Us

Birthlink was established in 1911 and owns and manages the Adoption Contact Register for Scotland which began in 1984. All people aged 16 and over whose birth and/or adoption took place in Scotland can register, as well as birth mothers, birth fathers and any other birth relatives. We also offer a searching service where trained volunteer genealogists find the contacts people are looking for from public record. After matches are made on the register, or people are located, service users can choose to enter into a period of mediation to reunite with estranged family members if this is their mutual wish. The adoption contact register also gives siblings an opportunity to reunite if they were separated in childhood. The service extends to accessing original court papers relating to adoption on behalf of service users who may not be able to travel to the National Records of Scotland in Edinburgh to access these.

Birthlink also operates the After Adoption Information Line where anyone affected by adoption can seek advice and support. This is also used as a consultation service open to professionals seeking support on case work. Expertise is also shared with Local Authorities through a quarterly professionals' forum and various bespoke training is regularly delivered on request.

Separately, Birthlink is funded by Future Pathways to undertake Subject Access Requests for people seeking to understand their time in care. The agency is also funded specifically to support people seeking to access their care records in preparation for application to Redress Scotland.

Things To Consider

If you are part of a fundraising team but you would like to track your own fundraising, we would recommend that you set up a team page on JustGiving where you can link your individual pages together.

Your supporters can Gift Aid their donations on your page, if they are taxpayers and reside in the UK. This can add up to 25% extra to their donation so it's worth reminding your friends and family. JustGiving collect everything, so it's an easy way to boost your total.

#### **Raffles and Lotteries**

Holding a raffle is a great way to raise funds, but there are some legal limitations that you need to be aware of. If you pay for a ticket and receive the prize on the same day, this is considered a raffle and does not require a licence.

If you purchase a ticket in advance, and the winning ticket is drawn on a different day, then this is considered a lottery. Some lotteries require licences, to find out more please see this information from the Gambling Commission:

#### Food Hygiene

If you are selling food during your event, you will need to make sure that the vendor/caterer is licensed. If you are making food yourself, make sure the public know the ingredients. Writing a card with a list of ingredients for each item is a good way of doing this. For information about food hygiene regulations, visit: www.food.gov.uk

#### **Collecting for BIRTHLINK**

We have official BIRTHLINK branded collection tins, buckets and boxes that you can use at your event. As we are registered with the Fundraising Regulator, there are guidelines that must be followed before we can send your collection tins out.

If your event is in a public area, you will need permission from the local council to collect donations.

In some cases, you may need a licence.

However, if the land is privately owned then this does not apply. You will need to obtain written permission from the property or venue owner, that they are happy for you to collect using a collection tin in their venue. Once you have received permission, we have a short form for you to fill out and then we can send out your collection tins.

#### **Birthday Fundraising**

Two weeks before your birthday, Facebook will send you a notification asking if you'd like to raise money for a charitable cause to celebrate your birthday. From here, all you need to do is click yes and search for BIRTHLINK. You can also choose to set up a fundraising page or add a 'donate now' button to your latest post. #### Social Media

Posting on social media is a fantastic way to boost your fundraising total, but please do be aware of what you are posting.

Please be aware that when you post any information or photographs online it becomes public information, and the press may use it. If you are fundraising in memory of a friend, please do also check you have permission to fundraise in their loved one's name. Don't put up images that you or the deceased's family do not want shared. Once is it in the public domain it can be accessed and used by anyone anywhere in the world. This includes on your online fundraising page and on social media.

If you are setting up a Facebook page/event, or a website for your fundraising, we ask all our fundraisers to include the text below somewhere on their page,

just to ensure that there isn't any confusion around which social media platforms are the official BIRTHLINK channel and which are third-party.

"I am fundraising in aid of BIRTHLINK. All monies raised will go to BIRTHLINK, but I am acting in my own capacity. BIRTHLINK is not responsible for the content on this page and accepts no liability. The views and articles shared on this page are not in any way endorsed by or advocated by BIRTHLINK."
